

ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2017-2018 OF Christian College Incubation Center (CCIC)

The Christian College Incubation Center was formed as an initiative to promote and facilitate knowledge creation, innovation and entrepreneurship activities on and off the campus for the student community. It was established as a center which could generate knowledge and skilled human resource which would lead to “self sufficiency”. The following activities were undertaken during the Academic year 2017-2018:

1. LED Display board- Fabrication, Installation and Programming

One week training was provided to selected students for Fabrication, Installation and Programming of an LED display board by “PROXY DEVELOPERS” Chengannur a startup venture by B.Tech Students of College of Engineering, Chengannur. The select group of students from Christian college chengannur spent around 60 hours to fabricate and install the LED display board. The board was purchased by the management of Christian college chengannur and was installed on the campus on 12.12.2017 at 21:05 pm.



The students offer servicing and consistent programming updates for the board which is displayed on the office wall of the college. All important notices of the college are displayed on the board. This has enabled to reduce manual labor involved in providing notices to each class room. It also has enabled to pass on information regarding activities, examinations, fees and hall arrangements on the campus in an efficient manner.

2. LED Tube light manufacturing

One day training was provided to selected students on Fabrication and Installation of LED tube-lights by “PROXY DEVELOPERS” Chengannur a startup venture by B.Tech Students of College of Engineering, Chengannur. Ten tube lights were made by the students of Christian college chengannur. The tubelights where christened as “C³Lights”. The tube lights were purchased by the faculty and students of the college. A total of 16 fluorescent tube lights on the campus were replaced with LED tube lights manufactured in the campus.



3. Seed Funding- Attire Marketing, Kennel Breeding

Mr. Jithu S Kumar a third year B.Sc. Chemistry student was provided with interest free Seed money to start an Attire Marketing venture. A seed money of Rs. 4000/- was provided to him. The seed money was returned by him and he has submitted accounts showing a profit of Rs. 1500/-.



Mr. Nirmal Solomon a second year B.A. Economics student was provided with interest free Seed money to start a Kennel Breeding venture. A seed money of Rs. 4000/- was provided to him. He has proposed to refund the money by July 30, 2018.
