

INTRODUCTION



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


3. International Day Against Drug Abuse (23-06-2023)




4. Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Class (14-07-2023)

5. Blood Donation Camp (07-08-2023)



6. Sex education (08-08-2023)






8. Geriatric Care and Basic Life Support Class (29-09-2023)

12. National Unity Day (31 – 10- 2023)



13. Kerala Piravi day (01-11-2023)



14. General Counselling for Youth and Relationship session (14-11-2023)




17. World Aids Day (01-12-2023)



thanks, acknowledging the contributions of all involved. The programme was attended by 200 participants. Refreshments were provided.




